Passengers may board or exit a bus at any marked bus stop. Stops are identified with signs.



## FARES & PASSES

### Single Fare

Adult: \$1  
Youth (7-17): 50¢  
Youth (0-6): Free  
K-State ID: Free

### Passes

1-Day Pass: \$2  
3-Day Pass: \$4  
5-Day Pass: \$6  
Monthly Pass: \$30

### Where to Get a Pass\*

Passes may be purchased at the aTa Bus office, any Dillons store in Manhattan, City Hall, HyVee, and the Health Department.

### All Transfers are Free!

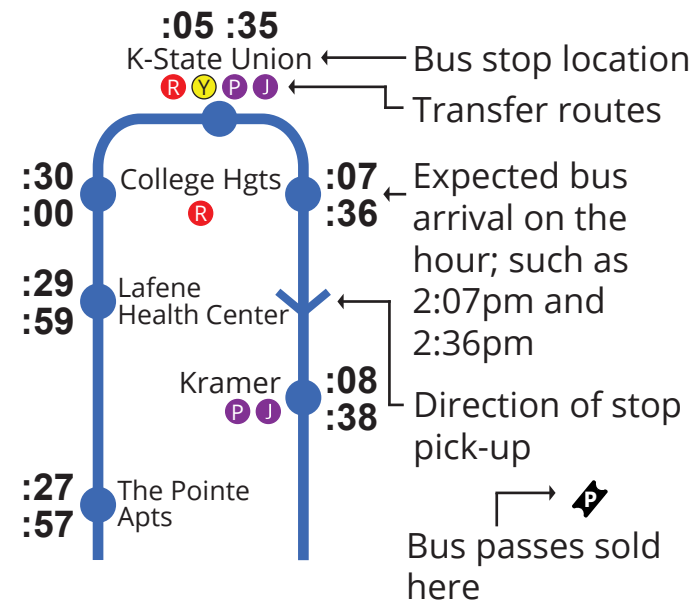
Exact change ONLY on-bus ticket purchase.
