Shall the City of Manhattan, Kansas be authorized to impose an additional three tenths of one percent (0.3%) general retailers' sales tax, thereby increasing the general sales tax currently in effect, on all applicable retail sales occurring within the City, pursuant to the authority of K.S.A. 12-187 *et seq.*, to be used for all lawful expenditures of the City and intended to reduce the impact on the ad valorem property tax burden on City taxpayers with collection of such tax beginning on April 1, 2020, or as soon as provided by law?
