Riley County Rules for Public Use of Cameras, Photographic Lights and Other Recording Devices During Pandemic

1. K.S.A. 75-4318(e) of the Kansas Open Meetings Act allows counties to restrict the use of cameras, photographic lights and recording devices during any public meeting.
2. Cameras, photographic lights and other recording devices shall only be used by the public during any Riley County public meeting while the user is seated in a chair placed by Riley County staff in the public gallery of the County Commission meeting room, or while seated in a chair placed by Riley County staff in the room adjoining the County Commission meeting room. Six feet of social distancing from all other public meeting attendees shall be observed at all times.
3. Members of the public using cameras, photographic lights and other recording devices during any Riley County Commission public meeting shall not use any such devices at any other location within the County Commission meeting room or at any other location within the room adjoining the County Commission meeting room. Six feet of social distancing from all other public meeting attendees shall be observed at all times.

The foregoing rules are reasonable rules, intended to promote the orderly and dignified conduct of the public business of Riley County. Members of the public who violate any one or more of these rules shall be asked to leave the public meeting.
