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**LOCAL HEALTH OFFICER ORDER NO. 22
ISSUED APRIL 30, 2021**

Pursuant to the authority provided in K.S.A. 65-119, K.S.A. 65-129b, K.S.A. 65-202 and other applicable laws and regulations, this Order No. 22 is issued. **I continue to strongly recommend everyone maintain social distancing, use proper hand hygiene such as washing your hands with soap and water, or use hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol, and wear a face mask or face covering, all consistent with Centers for Disease Control and Prevention guidelines.**

In my capacity as the Riley County Local Health Officer, I have determined this Order No. 22 is appropriate within that portion of Riley County Kansas outside the boundary of the City of Manhattan.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED this Order No. 22 supersedes and rescinds my Order 21, which was issued March 25, 2021.


SECTION ONE: My Order No. 21 had **required** both Social Distancing and a face mask or face covering for persons within Riley County but outside the boundary of the City of Manhattan, with certain listed exceptions.

SECTION TWO: This Order No. 22 **revokes** all Social Distancing and face mask or face covering **requirements** I previously ordered for all persons within Riley County but outside the boundary of the City of Manhattan. On the effective date of this Order No. 22, Social Distancing and face mask or face coverings are **no longer required** by me for persons within Riley County but outside the boundary of the City of Manhattan.

SECTION THREE: Nothing in this order shall be construed to prevent any municipality within Riley County from requiring a face mask or face covering, nor to prevent any business or property from requiring a face mask or face covering for their employees, guests, or customers.

SECTION FOUR: This Order supersedes and revokes "Local Health Officer Order No. 21" **effective at 11:59 pm on the 2nd of May, 2021** and this "Local Health Officer Order No. 22" shall thereafter remain in effect until amended, superseded, or rescinded in writing, by the Riley County Local Health Officer or the Board of Riley County Commissioners, sitting as the Board of Health.
